#### Why 1 Corinthians?

- As we grow...
  - We want to <u>care</u> for every single member of a relatively large church.
- As we go...
  - We want to be <u>faithful</u> to God's Word as God's people in a rapidly shifting culture.

## The Church... A Community Formed By The Cross

- The cross humbles us.
  - o The contrast...
    - To those who are perishing, the cross seems <u>absurd</u>.
    - To those who are being saved, the cross evokes awe.
  - o The cause...
    - Not the specific <u>quality</u> of those who are called.
    - Only the sovereign mercy of the One who calls.
  - o The caution...
    - Recognize the <u>initiative</u> of God.
    - Remember the <u>responsibility</u> of man.
  - o The conclusion...
    - We don't revel in the <u>wisdom</u> or the ways of this world.
    - We only revel in the <u>grace</u> and the glory of our God.
- The cross satisfies us.
  - o Because of the cross, all of our guilt is gone.
  - o Because of the cross, all of God's gifts are ours.
- The cross <u>unifies</u> us.
  - o The cross erases any reason for division among us.
  - o The cross exalts the only One who died for us.
- The cross transforms us.
  - Christ is our righteousness: He has saved us from sin's penalty.
  - Christ is our sanctification: He is saving us from sin's power.
  - Christ is our redemption: He will save us from sin's <u>presence</u>.
- The cross <u>compels</u> us.
  - We want to <u>reflect</u> the holiness of God.
  - o We want to proclaim the hope of the gospel.
- The cross assures us.
  - The Christ who came to die on a cross is the Christ who's coming to usher in a kingdom.
