
Jesus calls us to make his glory known among all the nations by making disciples and multiplying churches. Being on mission is not a program, but the calling of our lives as Christians.

- Pray for seminary students in East Asia who cannot study openly in their home context but desire to see the gospel spread and churches planted in their region.





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PRAYER MOMENT

PRAY FOR MINISTRY EFFORTS IN THE RED ZONES (EVANGELISM, PASTOR TRAINING, AND CHURCH PLANTING).

- Pray for the leaders of college campus ministries in East Asia who are spreading the gospel and helping new believers grow in their faith.
 Pray for Southeast Asian church planters as they are being equipped and prepared to carry out the ministry that God has called them to.
- Pray for ministry workers who are creating and posting culturally relevant, thought-provoking content on social media platforms to engage seekers with the gospel and connect believers with follow-up groups.
- Pray that more pastors in the red zones would have access to solid, biblical teaching, resources, and programs that train them to preach faithfully from God's Word.

- Pray that we would see more Asian believers being trained to move across cultures as missionaries. Pray that these trainees will be equipped to take the gospel to people and places in restrictive-access countries where Christ is little-known.
- Pray that we would be able to provide a theologically sound training for local church leaders and encourage church leaders and pastors to more faithfully engage their local communities with the gospel.
- Pray for small business projects to provide steady income and ministry opportunities for local believers and to ultimately provide gospel access to unreached people groups in Southeast Asia.




